11 **I. Charges**

12 1,000,000 counts felony murder,

17 **II. Motives**

18 The defendant, Joseph Stalin, was dictator of the USSR from 1929
19 to 1953 (History.com Staff). He implemented systematic plans to
20 turn the USSR into an industrial superpower. His plans centered
21 around the government fully controlling all aspects of society.

24 **III. Results**

2 camps for decades under deplorable conditions.

3 **IV. Apprehension**

4 Stalin was never apprehended, in that he was never brought to
5 justice for his crimes during his lifetime. His reign of terror
6 ended only upon his death. It took years to clean up in the
7 aftermath.

8 **V. Conclusions**

9 Joseph Stalin was a tyrant who ruled largely by inflicting terror
10 upon anyone who did not agree with him. He was very systematic, a
11 natural and charismatic leader, manipulative, immoral, and a
12 mentally unstable man. He deserved to be held accountable for his
13 crimes. During his lifetime, he was not brought to justice.
14 However, we can still provide closure for those who were held
15 captive, and to the family members of those who did not survive.

16 **VI. Sentence Request**

17 One can rest comforted in the fact that Mr. Stalin will meet his
18 rightful punishment, as there will be a final judgment.
